**Course Description:** Course is a classic flat four-corner criterium course. Start-finish is in front of the Transportation Cabinet on Mero Street, and the half-mile course runs counterclockwise on portions of St. Clair, Clinton, and High streets.

**Details:** All USA Cycling rules apply. Free-lap rule is in effect. Lapped riders may be pulled at the officials' discretion. You must present a valid 2009 USA Cycling license at registration to enter any race. Only Category 5 men and Category 4 women who do not have a valid racing license may purchase a one-day license for \$10.00 at registration. First-time women racers race for free. Promoters reserve the right to shorten, modify, cancel, or combine any race or prize list in the event of insufficient entries or bad weather. Day of race registration opens at 9:00 a.m. and closes 15 minutes before the start of each race. There must be twice as many racers as there are places paid. Helmets are required.
